Travel Information

Currency

The currency in Cambodia is the Riel; in Hong Kong, the HK dollar; in Indonesia, the Rupiah; in Japan, the Yen; in Malaysia, the Ringgit; in Maldives, the Rufiyaa; in Singapore, the SGD dollar; in Thailand, the Baht; and in Vietnam, the Dong. It is recommended to exchange some currency before you leave home or prior to exiting the airport on arrival.

Electricity

Standard electrical service in Cambodia is 230 volt; Hong Kong and Indonesia are 220 volt; Japan is 100 volt; Malaysia is 240 volt; Maldives is 230 volt; Singapore is 220-240 volt; Thailand and Vietnam are 220 volt. A converter may be necessary for all countries for voltage compatibility. With many countries differing in their use of round or square, 2-pronged or 3-pronged plugs, it is highly recommended that travelers carry an 'all-in-one' travel adapter.

Customs and Import Restrictions

Many countries have restrictions and prohibitions on what you can bring into a country including produce, chewing gum, tobacco and religious literature. Be sure to check with the foreign embassies and consulates in the U.S. for your destination country before departure.
